Differently Abled IT skills

To provide sustainable employment opportunities for the Hearing Impaired (HI) trainees at ANEW, we have partnered with V-shesh accessible services Pvt Ltd, an impact enterprise in the field of disability placements and a Hellen Keller award winner for the year 2014. Further to IT skills training at ANEW, V-shesh offers job specific training and placements for HI trainees along with sensitization programs for the employer.

ANEW has agreed upon a joint proposal from NIIT & Wadhvani Foundation, to sponsor the Hearing Impaired trainees who have been successfully employed after their training at ANEW. As per the agreement, hearing impaired candidates trained under this partnership program will be recognized under the banner of the *Wadhvani Foundation OND (Opportunity Network for the Disabled)* and will be awarded a Wadhvani Foundation branded certificate along with NIIT Foundation.

Certificate Distribution

65 Basic IT trainees including 5 Differently Abled trainees received their NIIT Certificates on 11.12.2013. Mrs. Gita Karunakaran, Head Corporate Affairs, Scope International felicitated the program as the Chief Guest.

Home Nursing

Whenever there are camps conducted, our ANEW Home Nursing trainees are always given the first preference to volunteer at the camps.
